Step 1

Counselling sessions with a qualified counsellor and/or one to one Family Support via a Key Worker, who will support the parent to work through and prioritise their needs via our Assessment of Need form.

5 week Parenting & Life Skills courses, facilitated by qualified staff – parents will be encouraged to become mentors and supporters of new parents.

Volunteering opportunities and a Taking Steps Back to Work programme provided to support lone parents who are ready to take this step, specifically tailored to meet the needs of lone parents.
